Simulations are very important in developing the leadership skills of a physician in a resuscitation case. Almost all of our Emergency staff have participated and learned to communicate with the team more efficiently ultimately improving the quality of care of the patient in the process. While this is predominantly for the Emergency Department staff members from other departments have been invited to attend at times, including pediatrics, internal medicine and obstetrics.

OUTCOMES:

We have had great success so far with the simulation program, but unfortunately it was largely put on hold during increased volume time over the past 8 months, and a lack of space to run the scenarios. The interest for a full-scale revival of the program is now back and we will hopefully run at least one session of three scenarios per month with the possibility of maybe increasing this further dependent on demand.
